## ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1982

Made . . . . . 23rd December 1982

Coming into operation . . . . . 7th February 1983

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 132(2), 135(2) and 218(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel(b) as regards regulation 2, hereby makes the following Regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982 and shall come into operation on 7th February 1983.

*Regulation amended*

2. For regulation 18 of the Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974(c) there shall be substituted—

*“Fees*

18.—(1) A person applying to submit himself to the written part of the examination shall pay a fee of £25.

(2) A person applying to submit himself to the practical part of the examination shall pay a fee of £60.

(3) The fee to be paid by a person who applies for the entry of his name in the Register shall be £50.

(4) The fee to be paid by a person who applies for the renewal of an entry of his name in the Register for a further period of four years shall be £60.

(5) The fee to be paid by a person exempted under regulation 20(1) applying for the entry of his name in the Register shall be £60.

(6) The fee to be paid by a person who applies for the re-entry of his name in the Register shall be £60 if that person's name has been removed from the Register and by virtue of regulation 20(3) he is not required again to pass the examination.

(7) The fee to be paid by a person applying for a licence or a renewal thereof shall be £45.”

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations further amend the Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974 ("the 1974 Regulations") by increasing the fees for—

- (a) the written part of the examination, from £15 to £25;
- (b) the practical part of the examination of ability to give instruction, from £35 to £60;
- (c) an application for entry in the Register following the passing of the examination, from £30 to £50;
- (d) an application for retention on the Register, from £35 to £60;
- (e) an application for entry on the Register by a person on the corresponding Register in Great Britain from £35 to £60;
- (f) an application for re-entry on the Register where the applicant is not required to pass the examination in the circumstances described in regulation 20(3) of the 1974 Regulations from £35 to £60; and
- (g) an application for a licence or renewal thereof to give instruction from £25 to £45.
