Seed Potato Marketing Scheme (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1982*Made* 2nd March 1982*Coming into operation* 16th April 1982

The Department(a) of Agriculture for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 2(4) of the Agricultural Marketing Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the representatives of the producers of seed potatoes and any other interests which appear to the Department(a) to be directly affected by the Scheme hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Seed Potato Marketing Scheme (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982, and shall come into operation on 16th April 1982.

Amendment of the Scheme of 1961

2. In paragraph 4 of the Schedule to the Seed Potato Marketing Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1961(c) for sub-paragraph (1) there shall be substituted the following:—

“(1) Members of the Board who hold office at 31st May 1982, shall remain in office until 31st May 1984, or until the Board has been wound up whichever is the earlier, notwithstanding anything contained in paragraphs 4(2), 5, 6 and 8(1)(a) relating to the election and appointment of members to the Board.”
