**The Bankruptcy (1980 Order) (Commencement No. 2) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1982**

Made 8th March 1982

The Department of Commerce, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(3) of the Bankruptcy Amendment (Northern Ireland) Order 1980(a) and paragraph 2(1)(b) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) hereby makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Bankruptcy (1980 Order) (Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982.

Commencement

2. Article 33 of the Bankruptcy Amendment (Northern Ireland) Order 1980 shall come into operation on 15th March 1982.
