ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

On-Street Parking (Belfast) (Revocation) Bye-Laws
(Northern Ireland) 1982

Made	22nd March 1982
Coming into operation	21st April 1982

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 107(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Bye-laws:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the On-Street Parking (Belfast) (Revocation) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1982 and shall come into operation on 21st April 1982.

Revocation

2. The Bye-laws specified in the Schedule are hereby revoked.
