Probation (Residential Payments) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1983

Made 20th June 1983

Coming into operation 22nd July 1983

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State in pursuance of Article 5(3)(b) of the Probation Board (Northern Ireland) Order 1982(a) hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Probation (Residential Payments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 22nd July 1983.

Payments by Board in respect of persons subject to residence requirement

2.—(1) The payments which may be made under Article 5(3)(b) of the Probation Board (Northern Ireland) Order 1982 (payments in respect of persons under supervision of probation officer and required by probation order to reside in any place otherwise than for treatment for mental condition as resident patients) shall be any payment to which this regulation applies and the persons to whom they may be made shall be any person to whom this regulation applies.

(2) This regulation applies to any payment in respect of a person residing in accommodation provided by another person (including an organisation or other body), being the payment of a reasonable sum in respect of—

- (a) the provision to the person residing there, of that accommodation;
- (b) the maintenance or treatment of the person residing in that accommodation;
or
- (c) expenses incurred by the person residing in that accommodation in travelling to or from it,

and this regulation applies to the person providing that accommodation.
