Foyle Area (Definition of the Mouth of the River Roe)
Regulations 1983

Made	4th July 1983
Coming into operation	27th July 1983

The Foyle Fisheries Commission, in exercise of its powers under section 13(1) of the Foyle Fisheries Act 1952(a) and section 13(1) of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1952(b) with the approval of the Minister for Fisheries and Forestry in the Republic of Ireland(c) and of the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland(d) hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (Definition of the Mouth of the River Roe) Regulations 1983, and shall come into operation on 27th July 1983.

Interpretation

2. "the Foyle Fisheries Acts" means the Foyle Fisheries Act 1952 and the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1952.

Definition

3. The mouth of the River Roe flowing into Lough Foyle is hereby defined to be a straight line, marked M on the map or plan in the Schedule and drawn on a line bearing 231° 30' true from the point marked O at Balls Point on the said map or plan at the most westerly point at High Water Mark Mean Tide of the townland of Scotchtown, barony of Keenaght and the County of Londonderry, to the point marked P on the said map or plan at High Water Mark Mean Tide at Ballymacran Bank in the townland of Myroe Level (Intake), barony of Keenaght and the County of Londonderry; and the point or points of the mouth of the River Roe from which distances are to be measured under the Foyle Fisheries Acts are hereby defined to be any and every point on the aforesaid straight line marked M.

Revocation

4. The definition of the Mouth of the River Roe made by the Special Commissioners of Irish Fisheries on 8th February 1864 is hereby revoked.

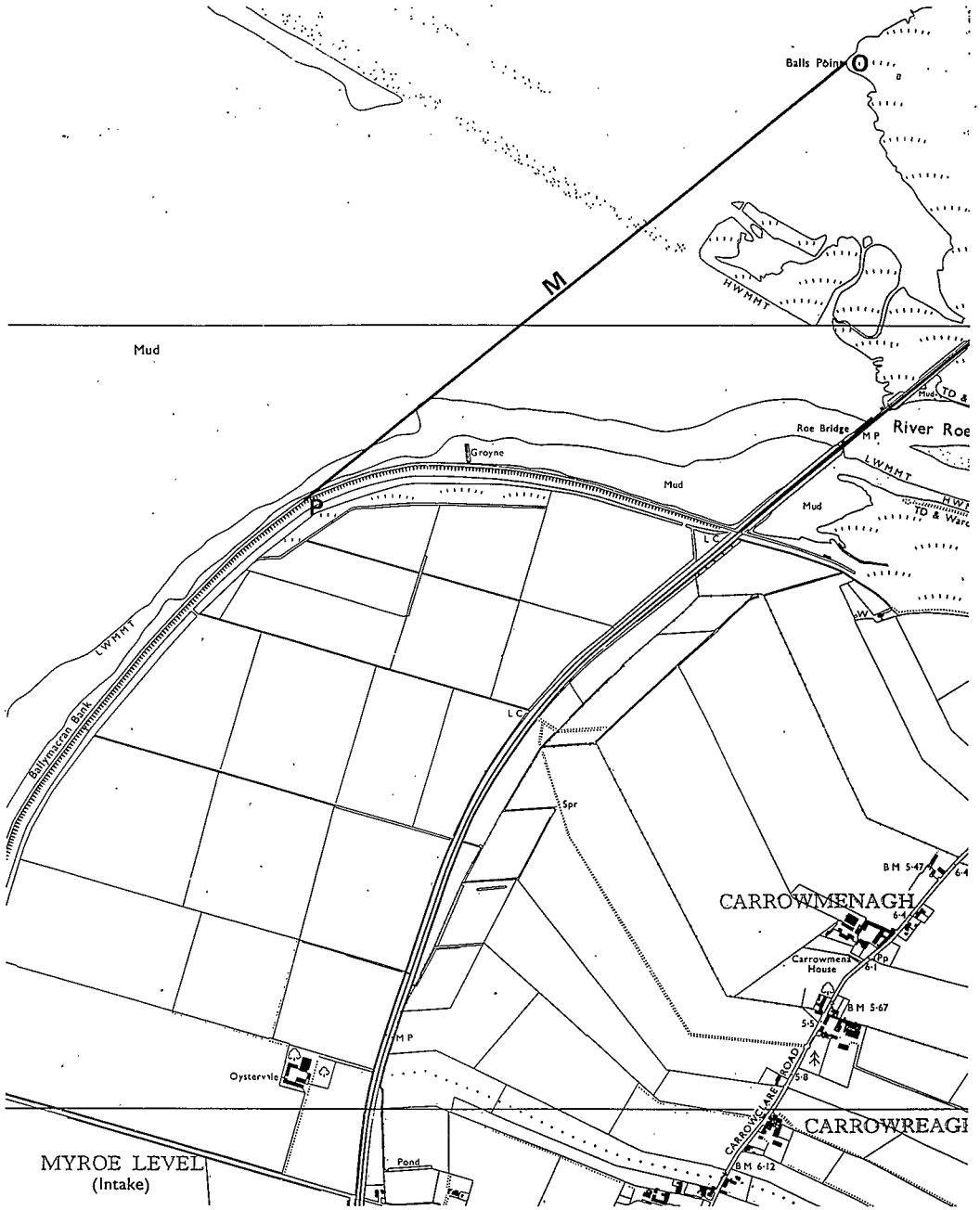

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations re-define the mouth of the River Roe.

Under the Foyle Fisheries Acts it is an offence:—

- (a) for any person (other than the owner of a several fishery) to shoot, draw or use any net for taking salmon at the mouth of any river or within half a mile seaward or half a mile inwards or along the coast from the mouth of any river; and
- (b) for any person to shoot, draw or stretch any net entirely across the mouth of a river.
