Students Awards (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1983

Made . . . . . 4th August 1983

Coming into operation . . . . . 31st August 1983

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 39(1) and (2)(a), 40(2)(a) and Article 125(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Students Awards (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on 31st August 1983 and shall have effect on and from 1st September 1982.

*Amendment of Students Awards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982*

2. The Students Awards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982(c) shall be amended as follows:—

(a) in paragraph 6(1)(a) of Schedule 8 the words “otherwise than in Sections 19 and 20 (life policy premiums etc.)” shall be omitted;

(b) after paragraph 6(2)(b) of, that Schedule there shall be added—

“(bb) the amount of any payment or deduction in respect of which relief is given under Section 19 or 20 of the Income and Corporation Taxes Act 1970(d) (life policy premiums etc.), or would be given if those Sections were not subject to Section 21 of that Act;”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations, which have effect retrospectively on and from 1st September 1982, amend the provisions of Schedule 8 of the Students Awards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982, S.R. 1982 No. 235, under which the income of a student's parents is determined for the purposes of ascertaining the parent's contribution to the student's resources, and accordingly the amount of maintenance grant to which the student is entitled. Retrospection is authorised by Articles 39(2) and 40(2) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972, S.I. 1972/1263 (N.I. 12).

The amendment provides that any payment by a parent, or any deduction from his salary, of a kind which attracts tax relief under Section 19 or 20 of the Income and Corporation Taxes Act 1970 (life insurance premiums and certain similar payments) shall be deducted from the parent's gross income for the purpose mentioned above. Schedule 8 originally provided that only those payments which are deducted under Sections 19 and 20 in computing the parent's total income for tax purposes should be so deducted.

**1983 No. 211****Medicines (Exemptions from Restrictions on the Retail Sale or Supply of Veterinary Drugs) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1983**

This Order has been made by the Secretary of State concerned with health in England, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health and with agriculture in Scotland and in Wales, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 57(1)(2) and 129(4) of the Medicines Act 1968.

In pursuance of paragraph 11 of Schedule 4 to that Act this Order has been registered as a Northern Ireland statutory rule under the Statutory Rules (Northern Ireland) Order 1979. It is printed in full in the volume of United Kingdom Statutory Instruments for 1983 and has been numbered 1156 in that series.
