SEEDS

Seeds (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983

Made 5th August 1983

Coming into operation 1st September 1983

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1(1), 1(2A)(a), 2(2) and (4) of the Seeds Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with representatives of such interests as appear to it to be concerned and with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel with regard to the licensing fee for licensed testing establishments, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Seeds (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1983.

Revocation

2. The Seeds (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982(c) are hereby revoked.

Fees

3.—(1) There shall be paid in advance in respect of matters arising under the regulations referred to in Schedules 1 to 6 the fees set out in the second column of each of those Schedules opposite the respective references to such matters in the first column of each of such Schedules.

(2) The Department shall repay to an applicant one-half of any initial fee paid by an applicant in accordance with Schedules 1 to 5 if the application in respect of which the initial fee was paid is withdrawn by the applicant before the date of inspection of the crop in respect of which the application was made.

Persons to whom fees are payable

4.—(1) Where—

- (a) the inspection of a crop is undertaken by a licensed crop inspector; or
- (b) the sampling of a seed lot is undertaken by a licensed seed sampler; or
- (c) a testing of a sample of seeds is undertaken by a licensed testing establishment;

the fees for such inspection, sampling or testing shall be payable to the licensed crop inspector, the licensed seed sampler or the licensed testing establishment as the case may be.

(2) In sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph (1) "licensed" means licensed under regulation 8 of the Seeds (Registration and Licensing) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974(a).

Exemption

5. The Department may exempt any person or class of persons or persons generally from compliance with any of the provisions of these regulations and the exemptions may be made subject to conditions.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

regulations controlling the marketing of cereal seeds, fodder plant seeds, beet seeds, oil and fibre plant seeds, and vegetable seeds provide that seeds of these categories may only be marketed if they are derived from crops which on inspection are found to meet certain standards and if upon subsequent testing samples of the seed also meet certain standards.

These regulations which are made under the Seeds Act (Northern Ireland) 1965 set fees for seed certification and seed testing. They supersede the Seeds (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982.

The main changes between these regulations and the Seeds (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982 are that they increase:

- (a) seed certification and seed testing fees by approximately 9%;
- (b) the annual fee payable for a seed testing station licence from £1,150 to £1,300;
- (c) throughput fees payable to the Department of Agriculture by a seed testing station licensee to a single uniform fee of £2.85.
