The Social Security (Attendance Allowance) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983

Made 4th August 1983

Coming into operation 8th August 1983

The Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 35 and 85(1) of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Act 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations which correspond to provision contained in regulations made by the Secretary of State for Social Services in relation to Great Britain and which accordingly, by virtue of section 10(2) of, and paragraph 21 of Schedule 3 to, the Social Security Act 1980(b) are not subject to the requirement of section 10(1) of that Act for prior reference to the Social Security Advisory Committee:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Attendance Allowance) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 8th August 1983.

(2) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Social Security (Attendance Allowance) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975(c).

Amendment of the principal regulations

2.—(1) The principal regulations shall be amended in accordance with the following provisions of this regulation.

(2) In paragraph (2) of regulation 7 (children in hospital and certain other accommodation) at the beginning there shall be inserted—

“Subject to paragraph (2A)”.

(3) After paragraph (2) of regulation 7 there shall be inserted the following paragraph—

“(2A) Where—

- (a) on a day or days falling within the period of 4 weeks ending immediately before 8th August 1983 a child has been living in accommodation in circumstances in which paragraph (1)(b) applies in his case; and
- (b) since that day or the last of those days there has not been an interval of at least 29 consecutive days when that paragraph did not apply in the case of that child,

paragraph (2) shall not operate to make attendance allowance payable in respect of that child for any day throughout which he is living in such accommodation.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations further amend regulation 7 of the Social Security (Attendance Allowance) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 relating to children in hospital and other accommodation, so that the provision whereby attendance allowance may be paid in respect of a child for the first 4 weeks that a child is residing in accommodation where the cost is borne or may be borne out of public or local funds shall not apply in respect of a child who was living in such accommodation on any day in the 4 weeks before 8th August 1983 until an interval of at least 29 days elapses during which he does not live in such accommodation.
