## Teachers' Salaries (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983

Made . . . . . 1st September 1983

Coming into operation . . . . . 29th September 1983

The Department of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 57(1) and (4) and 125(1) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 29th September 1983 and shall have effect on and from 1st September 1983.

*Amendment of Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981*

2. The Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981(b) shall be amended as follows:—

(1) In Regulation 21(1)(b) (acting allowances) the words "in the prolonged absence of that teacher or pending the permanent appointment of a new teacher" are hereby revoked.

(2) After Regulation 21 there shall be inserted:

*"Allowances for project workers engaged in the curriculum development programme*

**21A.** A teacher who is employed in a secondary school and who is designated by the employing authority as a project worker engaged in the curriculum development programme for less able fourth and fifth year pupils shall receive in addition to his salary an allowance of £711 per annum so long as he continues to be so designated."

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

This rule amends the Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981 by removing the words "in the prolonged absence of that teacher or pending the permanent appointment of a new teacher" in Regulation 21(1)(b) (acting allowances) and by introducing a new allowance of £711 for certain teachers engaged in a curriculum development programme in secondary schools.
