The Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 98, 106 and 107 of and Schedule 15 to the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel(b), hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Charges for Drugs and Appliances (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983, and shall come into operation on 21st November 1983.

Amendment of regulations

2. The Health and Personal Social Services (Charges for Drugs and Appliances) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(c) shall be further amended by substituting for sub-paragraph (iii) of regulation 15(1)(f)(ii)(B) the following sub-paragraph—

- "(iii) such amount (if any) as is considered reasonable to meet housing costs;".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations further amend the Health and Personal Social Services (Charges for Drugs and Appliances) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973. They amend the list of items treated as included in the requirements and resources of a person in determining them where such person applies for an exemption certificate, by substituting, for an amount for repayments of mortgage capital, an amount for housing costs.
