ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1983

Made 30th November 1983

Coming into operation 9th January 1984

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 11(1) and 218(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983 and shall come into operation on 9th January 1984.

Regulation amended

2. In regulation 16(1) of the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981(b) for “£13.00” there shall be substituted “£14.40”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981 by increasing the fee for a driving test on all types of vehicles except invalid carriages (for which no fee is payable) from £13.00 to £14.40.
