The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 22(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and being satisfied that the lengths of road specified in the Schedule are unsuitable for use by certain classes of vehicles, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Weight Restriction (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984 and shall come into operation on 10th August 1984.

Prohibition

2. Save as provided in Article 3 the use by vehicles exceeding 3 tonnes in weight, whether laden or unladen, of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule is prohibited.

Exemptions

3. The prohibition in Article 2 shall not apply to vehicles being used either by the owners or occupiers of lands abutting on or convenient to the said lengths of road or in connection with the delivery to or collection from such lands of goods of any kind or in connection with public utility or emergency services.

SCHEDULE

- 1. Ardlough Road, Route C503, Londonderry, from its junction with Carmoney Road, Unclassified No. 131, to its junction with Route A6 at Drumahoe.
- 2. Rossdowney Road, Unclassified No. 120, Londonderry, from its junction with the Ardlough Road to its junction with the Crescent Link, Route A514.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

The effect of the Order is to prohibit vehicles exceeding 3 tonnes laden or unladen weight from using the lengths of road specified in the Schedule.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding $\pounds 100$.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the roads.
