Lands Tribunal (Salaries) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984

Made 23rd July 1984 Coming into operation 6th September 1984

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland) Act 1974

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(5) of the Lands Tribunal and Compensation Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), and now vested in me(c) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order:-

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Lands Tribunal (Salaries) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984 and shall come into operation on 6th September 1984.

Revocation

2. The Lands Tribunal (Salaries) Order (Northern Ireland) 1983(d) is hereby revoked.

Increases in salaries

- 3.—(1) The annual salary payable to the President of the Lands Tribunal shall be increased from 1st April 1984 from £32,750 to £33,733 and from 1st November 1984 from £33,733 to £35,000.
- (2) The annual salary payable to any other member of the Lands Tribunal shall be increased from 1st April 1984 from £31,000 to £31,930 and from 1st November 1984 from £31,930 to £3 $\hat{3}$,000.
