### Control of Traffic (Newtownards) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

# Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Traffic (Newtownards) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984 and shall come into operation on 3rd February 1985.

# Prohibition of right-hand turn

2. A person shall not cause or permit a vehicle to make a right-hand turn from Court Street into South Street, Newtownards.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prohibits vehicles from making a right-hand turn from Court Street into South Street, Newtownards.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £400.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road.
