The Department of Economic Development, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 33(1) of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1982(a) and every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

### Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Company and Business Names Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984, and shall come into operation on 2nd April 1984.

#### *Interpretation*

2. In these Regulations, "the Order" means the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1982, and "the Department" means the Department of Economic Development.

# Words and expressions requiring approval of the Department

3.—(1) The words and expressions stated in the first column of the Schedule are hereby specified as words and expressions for the registration of which as or as part of a company's corporate name the approval of the Department is required by Article 24(2)(b) of the Order or for the use of which as or as part of a business name the approval of the Department is required by Article 30(2)(b) of the Order.

(2) Each government department or other body stated in the second column of the Schedule is hereby specified as the relevant body for the purposes of Article 33(2) and (3) of the Order in relation to the word or expression opposite to it in the first column of the Schedule.

# EXPLANATORY NOTE

#### (This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations specify those words and expressions for the registration or use of which as or as part of a company or business name the approval of the Department of Economic Development is required by Articles 24(2)(b) or 30(2)(b) of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1982.

In the case of certain words or expressions, a government department or other body is specified as the relevant body to which a request in writing to indicate whether (and if so why) it has any objection to the use of a particular word or expression as or as part of a name, must be made under Article 33(2) and (3) of the Order. A statement that such a request has been made, and a copy of any response received is required to be delivered to the Department by Article 33(2) and (3).
