### Rates (Regional Rate) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974.

The Department of Finance and Personnel(a), in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 7(1) and Article 27(4) of the Rates (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Rates (Regional Rate) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1984.

## Regional rate

2. The regional rate for the year ending 31st March 1985 shall be 93.33 pence in the pound.

# Reduction of regional rate on dwellings

3. The amount by which the regional rate fixed for the year ending 31st March 1985 under Article 2 is to be reduced for the purposes of paragraph (2) and paragraph (3) of Article 27 of the Rates (Northern Ireland) Order 1977 shall be 12 pence.

This Order fixes 93.33 pence in the pound as the regional rate for the year ending 31st March 1985. It also fixes 12 pence as the amount by which the regional rate is to be reduced in respect of dwelling houses and hereditaments which, though not dwelling houses, are used partly for the purposes of private dwellings.
