ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985

Made 7th February 1985

Coming into operation 24th March 1985

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 24th March 1985.

Amendment

2. Schedule 2 to the One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982(b) shall be amended by the addition thereto of the following item:—

Column 1	Column 2
Montgomery Street, Belfast, from its junction with Victoria Square to its junction with Chichester Street	Southerly from Victoria Square
