Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment) Regulations 1985

Made 4th February 1985

Coming into operation 28th February 1985

The Foyle Fisheries Commission in exercise of its powers under section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act 1952(a) and section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1952(b) with the approval of the Minister for Fisheries and Forestry in the Republic of Ireland(c) and of the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland(d) hereby makes the following Regulation:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment) Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 28th February 1985.

Amendment to the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations 1976

2. There shall be substituted for the Schedule to the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations 1976(e) the following Schedule:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations 1976 by increasing the licence fees payable in 1985 in respect of each type of net used and game fishing licence issued in the Foyle Area.

The Regulations increase the age at which a person using a rod and line for game fishing is required to pay the full, rather than the lower level of licence fee, from 16 to 18 years.

The increases in licence fees payable in 1985 are set out below:—
