ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985

Made 16th October 1985

Coming into operation 28th November 1985

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1
to the Northern Ireland Act 1974

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 50(4) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985, and shall come into operation on 28th November 1985.

2. In relation to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule the rate of speed fixed by Article 50(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 shall be increased to forty miles per hour.

SCHEDULE

1. Annacloy Road, Route B2, Downpatrick, from a point approximately 195 metres west of its junction with Teconnaught Road, to a point approximately 2,325 metres east of that junction.
2. Movilla Road, Route B172, Newtownards, from a point approximately 244 metres east of its junction with the Donaghadee Road, Route A48, to a point approximately 1,400 metres east of that junction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order increases from 30 miles per hour to 40 miles per hour the speed limit on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule.
