ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**Traffic Weight Restriction (Gortscreagan Road) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1985**

Made 25th November 1985

Coming into operation 7th January 1986

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 22(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and being satisfied that the road specified in Article 2 is unsuitable for use by certain classes of vehicles makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Weight Restriction (Gortscreagan Road) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 7th January 1986.

Prohibition

2. Subject to Article 3 the use by vehicles exceeding 3 tonnes in weight, whether laden or unladen, of Gortscreagan Road (Unclassified No. 181) Co. Londonderry, from its junction with Slieveboy Road (Route C512) to its junction with Carnanreagh Road (Route C511) is prohibited.

Exemptions

3. The prohibition in Article 2 shall not apply to vehicles being used:—

- (a) by the owners or occupiers of lands abutting on or convenient to the said road; or
- (b) in connection with the delivery to or collection from such lands of goods of any kind or in connection with public utility or emergency services.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prohibits vehicles exceeding 3 tonnes laden or unladen weight from using Gortscreagan Road, (Unclassified No. 181) Co. Londonderry, from its junction with Slieveboy Road (Route C512) to its junction with Carnanreagh Road (Route C511).

Vehicles requiring access are exempted.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £400.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road concerned.
