The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(1) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 1 to, the Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1968(a), and now vested in it(b), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Fees (Increase) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 3rd February 1986.

Increase of fees

2.—(1) In section 5(3) of the Pedlars Act 1871(c) (pedlar's certificate) for "£9.00" (d) there shall be substituted "£12.25".

(2) In section 3 of the Street Trading (Regulation) Act (Northern Ireland) 1929(e) (street trading licence) for "£12.00"(d) there shall be substituted "£15.00".

Revocation

3. The Fees (Increase) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982(f) is hereby revoked.

This Order increases the fees (a) for a pedlar's certificate under section 5(3) of the Pedlars Act 1871 from ± 9.00 to ± 12.25 and (b) for a street trading licence under section 3 of the Street Trading (Regulation) Act (Northern Ireland) 1929 from ± 12.00 to ± 15.00 .
