**The Contracting-out (Protection of Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1985***Made* 16th December 1985*Coming into operation* 1st January 1986

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 43B(3) of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a) and Article 8(6) of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1985(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Contracting-out (Protection of Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1986.

(2) Regulation 2 shall have effect as from 1st January 1985.

(3) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Contracting-out (Protection of Pensions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984(c).

Insertion of regulation 7A in the principal regulations

2. After regulation 7 of the principal regulations there shall be inserted the following regulation—

“Assumptions to be made in determining the relevant sum in relation to widow’s benefit

7A. For the purposes of Article 43B(3) it shall be assumed that the earner died on the day after the termination of employment date, being then married to the wife to whom he was married on the date of his death, and being employed in employment to which the scheme applied if (and only if) he was employed in such employment on the date of his death, so however that no notional service after the termination of employment date shall be attributed to the earner by reason of this assumption.”.

**The Contracting-out (Protection of Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1985**

Coming into operation 1st January 1986

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 43B(3) of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a) and Article 8(6) of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1985(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Contracting-out (Protection of Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1986.

(2) Regulation 2 shall have effect as from 1st January 1985.

(3) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Contracting-out (Protection of Pensions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984(c).

Insertion of regulation 7A in the principal regulations

2. After regulation 7 of the principal regulations there shall be inserted the following regulation—

“Assumptions to be made in determining the relevant sum in relation to widow’s benefit

7A. For the purposes of Article 43B(3) it shall be assumed that the earner died on the day after the termination of employment date, being then married to the wife to whom he was married on the date of his death, and being employed in employment to which the scheme applied if (and only if) he was employed in such employment on the date of his death, so however that no notional service after the termination of employment date shall be attributed to the earner by reason of this assumption.”.
