Scheduled Diseases (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985

Made 28th March 1985

Coming into operation 6th May 1985

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 2(3), 10(6) and 16(2) of the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Scheduled Diseases (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985 and shall come into operation on 6th May 1985.

Revocation

2. The Parasitic Mange (Ireland) Order of 1919(b) and the Parasitic Mange (Northern Ireland) Order 1932(c) are hereby revoked.

Modification of the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981

3. The Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 is hereby modified as follows:

(1) in Part III of Schedule 1 (the list of diseases of animals) the words “30. Parasitic mange” shall be omitted;

(2) in Part II of Schedule 2 (compensation in respect of the slaughter of animals and poultry) for paragraph 10 there shall be substituted—

“10. *Johne's disease*: The compensation shall—

(a) where the animal slaughtered was affected with *Johne's disease*, be three-fourths of its value immediately before it was slaughtered; and

(b) in every other case, be the value of the animal immediately before it was slaughtered.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order modifies Schedule 1 to the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 (the 1981 Order) by omitting Parasitic mange from the list of diseases which are notifiable under the 1981 Order.

The Order also provides that the compensation payable on the slaughter of an animal affected with Johne's disease shall be three-fourths of its value immediately before it was slaughtered instead of three-fourths of its value immediately before it became affected.
