**The Family Income Supplements (General) (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1986**

<i>Made</i>	<i>3rd June 1986</i>
<i>Coming into operation</i>	<i>1st July 1986</i>

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 4(2)(a) of the Family Income Supplements Act (Northern Ireland) 1971(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Family Income Supplements (General) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1986.

(2) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Family Income Supplements (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980(b).

Amendment of regulation 2 of the principal regulations

2. In regulation 2(5) of the principal regulations (amounts to be deducted in calculating or estimating a person’s normal gross income), the following sub-paragraph shall be added after sub-paragraph (i)—

“(j) the whole of any Job Start Allowance payable pursuant to arrangements made by the Department of Economic Development(c) under section 1(1) of the Employment and Training Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(d).”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations further amend the Family Income Supplements (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 so as to provide that, in calculating or estimating a person's normal gross income for the purpose of determining entitlement to family income supplement, the whole of any Job Start Allowance payable under arrangements made by the Department of Economic Development is deducted.

The regulations correspond to provision contained in regulations made by the Secretary of State for Social Services in relation to Great Britain and accordingly, by virtue of section 10(2) of, and paragraph 21 of Schedule 3 to, the Social Security Act 1980 (c. 30) are not subject to the requirement of section 10(1) of that Act for prior reference to the Social Security Advisory Committee.
