**One-Way Traffic (Londonderry) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1986**

Made 12th June 1986
Coming into operation 27th July 1986

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Londonderry) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 27th July 1986.

Amendment

2. The One-Way Traffic (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981(b) shall be amended by the deletion from Schedule 2 of the item relating to Upper Bennett Street, Londonderry.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends the provisions of the One-Way Traffic (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981.

The amendment provides for the re-introduction of a two-way system of traffic in Upper Bennett Street, Londonderry.
