The Judgment Enforcement Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986

Made 17th December 1986

Coming into operation 21st January 1987

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116(1) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(a), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Judgment Enforcement Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 21st January 1987.

2. In the Schedule to the Judgment Enforcement Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1982(b) for fee No. 7 there shall be substituted the new fee set out in the Schedule to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Judgment Enforcement Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1982 to provide for a fee of £2 to be taken on an application for a search in the register of judgments. This fee is taken per name and is also taken on provision of a report that there are no entries in the register.

The new fee replaces that of £1 per name for a search in the index and of £2 per name for a search in the register.
