**One-Way Traffic (Dungannon) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1986**

Made 5th March 1986

Coming into operation 20th April 1986

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Dungannon) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 20th April 1986.

Amendment

2. Schedule 2 to the One-Way Traffic (Dungannon) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982(b) shall be amended by the addition thereto of the following item:—

<i>Column 1</i>	<i>Column 2</i>
Waterloo Place from its junction with Wellington Road to a point 32 metres north-east of that junction	North-easterly from Wellington Road.

This Order amends the provisions of the One-Way Traffic (Dungannon) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982.

The amendment provides for the introduction of a one-way system of traffic on a length of Waterloo Place, Dungannon.
