CRIMINAL PROCEDURE

Road Traffic (Fixed Penalty) (Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986

Made 5th March 1986

Coming into operation 21st April 1986

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 199(4) and 218(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Fixed Penalty) (Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 and shall come into operation on 21st April 1986.

Regulations amended

2. The Road Traffic (Fixed Penalty) (Procedure) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966(b) shall be amended as follows:

(1) For regulation 2 there shall be substituted—

“2. A notice under Article 199(4) or 200(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 offering the opportunity, by payment of a fixed penalty, of the discharge of any liability to conviction of an offence to which Articles 199 to 204 (other than Article 201) of that Order apply, shall be in the form set out in the Schedule.”

(2) For the Schedule there shall be substituted—

(a) S.I. 1981/154 (N.I. 1)
(b) S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1966 No. 116 as amended by S.R. 1983 No. 163

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Road Traffic (Fixed Penalty) (Procedure) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966 by providing for a new form of fixed penalty notice which does not require the alleged offence to be specified. It is sufficient for the notice to give reasonable information of the circumstances alleged to constitute the offence (Regulation 2).
