LEGAL AID AND ADVICE

**Legal Advice and Assistance (Financial Conditions) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1987***Made* 9th March 1987*Coming into operation* 6th April 1987*To be laid before Parliament*

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 3(2), 7(3) and 22(1) of the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and now vested in him(b), hereby makes the following Regulations—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice and Assistance (Financial Conditions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 6th April 1987.

(2) In these Regulations “the Order” means the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981.

Persons eligible for advice and assistance

2.—(1) For the weekly sum of £114 specified in Article 3(1)(a) of the Order, there shall be substituted the weekly sum of £118.

(2) For the capital sum of £800 specified in Article 3(1) of the Order, there shall be substituted the sum of £825.

Contributions from persons receiving advice and assistance

3. For the weekly sum of £54 specified in Article 7(2) of the Order, there shall be substituted the weekly sum of £56.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations increase the financial limits of eligibility for legal advice and assistance under Part II of the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981.

The income limits are increased to make legal advice and assistance available to those with disposable incomes of not more than £118 a week (instead of £114) and available without payment of a contribution to those with disposable incomes of £56 a week or less (instead of £54).

The capital limit is increased to make legal advice and assistance available to those with disposable capital of not more than £825 (instead of £800).
