## SOCIAL SECURITY

**The Social Security Benefits Up-rating (Amendment)  
Order (Northern Ireland) 1987**

*Made* . . . . . 13th March 1987

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 6th April 1987

Whereas the Secretary of State for Social Services has made an order(a) under section 63 of the Social Security Act 1986(b):

Now, therefore, the Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 64 of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(c) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Social Security Benefits Up-rating (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 6th April 1987.

(2) In this order “the up-rating order” means the Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order (Northern Ireland) 1987(d).

*Amendment of the up-rating order*

2. In paragraph 3 of Part V of the Schedule to the up-rating order (disablement pension under section 57(6) (weekly rates)), in column (2) of the Table for the amount “£19·85” there shall be substituted the amount “£19·35”.

This order corrects an error in the Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order (Northern Ireland) 1987 by changing the weekly rate of disablement pension, where the degree of disablement is 30 per cent., from £19·85 to £19·35.
