## Health and Personal Social Services (Food Premises) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 3(2) of the Health and Personal Social Services (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

#### Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Health and Personal Social Services (Food Premises) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 2nd March 1987.

Occupiers or owners of health and personal social services premises for the purposes of the food legislation

2. For the purposes of the food legislation a Board shall be treated as both the owner and occupier of premises used by the Board.

# Health and Personal Social Services EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations, which come into operation on 2nd March 1987, provide that, for the purposes of the Food and Drugs Act (Northern Ireland) 1958 (1958 c. 27) (and subordinate legislation thereunder) and the Control of Food Premises (Northern Ireland) Order 1979 (S.I. 1979/1710 (N.I. 17)), Health and Social Services Boards shall be treated as both owners and occupiers of health and social services premises used by them.
