ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**One-Way Traffic (Newtownards) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1987**

Made 30th April 1987

Coming into operation 14th June 1987

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published a notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Newtownards) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 14th June 1987.

Amendment

2. The One-Way Traffic (Newtownards) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985(b) shall be amended by the addition to the schedule of the following item:—

Column 1	Column 2
Robert Street from its junction with Brewery Lane to its junction with Thomas Street.	Westerly from Brewery Lane.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the One-Way Traffic (Newtownards) Order (Northern Ireland) 1985 (S.R. 1985 No. 182).

The amendment provides for the introduction of a one-way traffic system in Robert Street, Newtownards.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road.
