**Milk (Community Outgoers Scheme) (Amendment No. 2)  
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987**

*Made* . . . . . 15th May 1987

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 10th June 1987

The Department of Agriculture, being a Department designated(a) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(b) in relation to the Common Agricultural Policy of the European Community, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by that Section and of every other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Milk (Community Outgoers Scheme) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 10th June 1987.

*Interpretation*

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(c) shall apply to these regulations as it applies to a measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

*Amendment of the Milk (Community Outgoers Scheme) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986*

3. The Milk (Community Outgoers Scheme) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986(d) shall be amended as provided in Regulations 4 to 7.

4. In Regulation 2(2) (Interpretation)—

(a) for the definition of “Commission Regulation” there shall be substituted:

“ “Commission Regulation” means Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 2321/86(e) (laying down the detailed rules for the application of the Council Regulation) as amended by Regulation (EEC) No. 261/87(f);”

(b) for the definition of “Council Regulation” there shall be substituted:

“ “Council Regulation” means Council Regulation (EEC) No. 1336/86(a) (fixing compensation for the definitive discontinuation of milk production) as amended by Regulation (EEC) No. 776/87(b)”;

(c) the definition of “Ministers” shall be deleted.

5. In Regulation 4(1) (amount of compensation) the words “for the first year of application” shall be deleted.

6. For Regulation 5 (rules for acceptance of applications) there shall be substituted:

“5. For the purposes of Articles 1 and 3(2) of the Commission Regulation (Member States to make rules for the acceptance of applications) and subject to Article 1(2) second indent of the Council Regulation (Member States authorised to ensure that reductions are spread equally) where the sum of valid applications throughout the United Kingdom together relate to a quantity of eligible quota which exceeds 152,714,910 litres, the Department shall give preference to applications in order of receipt by it.”

7. In Regulation 6(2) (application for compensation) for “13th March 1987” there shall be substituted “30th December 1987”.

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations implement Council Regulation (EEC) No. 1336/86 (O.J. No. L119, 8.5.1986, p. 21) (as amended by Council Regulation (EEC) No. 776/87 (O.J. No. L78, 20.3.1987, p. 8)) fixing compensation for the definitive discontinuation of milk production, and Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 2321/86 (O.J. No. L202, 25.7.1986, p. 13) (as amended by Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 261/87 (O.J. No. L26, 29.1.1987, p. 18)) as regards the submission of applications for compensation for the definitive discontinuation of milk production in respect of the 1987/88 year by amending the Milk (Community Outgoers Scheme) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986 ("the principal regulations") as follows:

- (a) New definitions of "Commission Regulation" and "Council Regulation" are inserted in the principal regulations.
- (b) The Compensation Scheme is extended to the 1987/88 quota year and accordingly, the time limit (set by regulation 6 of the principal regulations) after which an applicant may not withdraw his application is further extended to 30th December 1987.
- (c) The total eligible quota that can be accepted throughout the United Kingdom under the Community Outgoers Scheme will not exceed 152,714,910 litres. The rules for acceptance of applications if they exceed this limit (laid down by regulation 5 of the principal regulations) are replaced by a system which gives preference to applications in the order in which they are received.
