**Companies (Consolidation of Fees) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1987**

Made 19th June 1987

Coming into operation 27th July 1987

The Department of Economic Development, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 309(4), 430(3), 657(1) and (4) and 681(1) of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Companies (Consolidation of Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 27th July 1987.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations—

“the Order” means the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1986.

Revocations

3. The Companies (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981(b), the Companies (Register of Disqualification Orders) (Fee) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982(c), the Companies (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983(d) and the Companies (Inspectors' Reports) (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983(e) are hereby revoked.

Fees

4.—(1) The prescribed fee for inspecting the register maintained by the Department under Article 309(2) of the Order shall be 5 pence.

(2) The prescribed fee for furnishing a copy of a report under Article 430(3) of the Order, or for furnishing a copy of a report or part of a report under that Article as it applies for the purposes of Article 436 of the Order, shall be 10 pence for each page copied.

(3) The fees specified in the second column of the Schedule shall be payable to the registrar in respect of the matters mentioned in the first column of the Schedule.

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations consolidate the Companies (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981, the Companies (Register of Disqualification Orders) (Fee) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982, the Companies (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983 and the Companies (Inspectors' Reports) (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1983.

The Regulations prescribe:

- (a) a fee of 5 pence to be paid for inspecting the register of disqualification orders maintained by the Department of Economic Development under Article 309(2) of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1986 ("the Order"); and
- (b) a fee of 10 pence per page copied for furnishing a copy of a report under Article 430(3) of the Order or under that Article as it applies for the purposes of Article 436 of the Order.

The Regulations set out:

- (c) a fee of £50 for the registration of a company on its formation under the Order;
- (d) a fee of £40 for entering on the register the name of a company assumed by virtue of the passing of a special resolution under Article 38(1) of the Order;
- (e) a fee of £50 for the re-registration of a private company as a public company pursuant to Article 53 of the Order;
- (f) a fee of £5 for the re-registration of a limited company as an unlimited company pursuant to Article 59 of the Order;
- (g) a fee of £50 for the re-registration of an unlimited company as a limited company pursuant to Article 61 of the Order;
- (h) a fee of £5 for the re-registration of a public company as a private company pursuant to Article 63 of the Order;
- (i) a fee of £50 for the registration under Chapter II of Part XXII of the Order of a company not formed under Companies legislation;
- (j) a fee of £1 for each inspection of documents kept by the registrar of companies;
- (k) a fee of £20 for the registration of a copy of an annual return, or of copies of documents delivered to the registrar in compliance with Article 649 of the Order;
- (l) a fee of 30 pence per page for certifying a copy of any document (other than a certificate of incorporation) kept by the registrar, and an additional fixed fee of £1; and
- (m) a fee for supplying a copy of the certificate of incorporation of a company (otherwise than on the incorporation of the company to which it relates) or a certified extract of any document kept by the registrar of £3.50 for the first such certificate or extract on any one

occasion and of £2·50 for any subsequent certificate or extract supplied on the same occasion.

No changes are made in the level of fees payable.
