ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Off-Street Parking (Amendment No. 9) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1987

Made 24th November 1987

Coming into operation 20th December 1987

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 105(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following bye-laws:—

Citation and commencement

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Off-Street Parking (Amendment No. 9) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 20th December 1987.

Amendment

2. The Off-Street Parking Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1983(b) shall be amended by the:—

- (a) deletion from Part I of the Schedule of the item numbered 291 relating to Harbour Square, Londonderry;
- (b) substitution for item numbered 193 in Part I of the Schedule of the item in the Schedule to these Bye-Laws.
