## POLICE

**Royal Ulster Constabulary (Amendment No. 2)  
Regulations 1987**

*Made . . . . . 19th November 1987*

*Coming into operation . . . . . 29th December 1987*

*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 25 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority for Northern Ireland and the Police Association for Northern Ireland, and after taking into account the recommendations made by the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom and furnishing that Board with a draft of the regulations in accordance with section 2(1) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(c), hereby with the concurrence of the Treasury makes the following regulations:—

*Citation, operation and effect*

**1.**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1987.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 29th December 1987 but shall have effect for the purposes of regulation 4, as from 1st February 1987 and, for the purposes of regulation 6, as from 1st June 1986 and, for the purposes of regulation 7, as from 1st July 1986 and, for the purposes of regulations 8 and 9, as from 1st September 1987.

*Interpretation*

**2.** In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Regulations 1984(d).

*Deductions from pay of social security benefits and statutory sick pay*

**3.** In regulation 35(1)(a) for the words “1982” there shall be substituted the words “1986”.

*Supplementary rent allowance*

4. In regulation 41(3)(a) and (b) of the principal regulations for the words “£8·33” there shall be substituted the words “£13·92”.

*Removal allowance*

5. In regulation 43(1)(d) of the principal regulations for the word “13” in the second place where it occurs there shall be substituted the word “39”.

*Annual leave*

6. In paragraph 3B(1) of Schedule 3 to the principal regulations:—

- (a) the words “an additional”; in each place where they occur should be omitted; and
- (b) for the words “in respect of”, in each place where they occur, there should be substituted the words “in lieu of”.

*University scholars*

7. In paragraph 3(2) of Schedule 4 to the principal regulations for the words “£885” there shall be substituted the words “£945”.

*Pay*

8. In Schedule 5 to the principal regulations for Tables A, B and C there shall be substituted respectively the Tables set out in the Schedule.

*Dog handler's allowance*

9. In Schedule 11 to the principal regulations there shall be substituted, in paragraph 1(a), for the words “£567” the words “£612”, and, in paragraph 1(b), for the words “£771” the words “£831”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Regulations 1984 (the principal regulations) with effect, as provided by regulation 1, for the purposes of regulation 4, as from 1st February 1987 (retrospection is authorised by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962), for the purposes of regulation 6, as from 1st June 1986, for the purposes of regulation 7, as from 1st July 1987, for the purposes of regulations 8 and 9, as from 1st September 1987 (retrospection is authorised by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962), and, for all other purposes, as from 29th December 1987.

Regulation 3 takes account of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1986.

Regulation 4 increases the supplementary rent allowance.

Regulation 5 increases the period in respect of which additional removal expenses may be paid at the discretion of the Police Authority.

Regulation 6 rectifies an ambiguity in the provision made by Regulation 5 of the Royal Ulster Constabulary (Amendment) Regulations 1986 (whereby a member recalled to duty during a period of annual leave is entitled to compensatory annual leave in lieu).

Regulation 7 increases the supplementary pay allowance for university scholars.

Regulation 8 increases the rates of pay for members of the force.

Regulation 9 increases the dog handler's allowance.

Retrospective effect is authorised by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
