ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

On-Street Parking (Amendment) Bye-Laws  
(Northern Ireland) 1987

Made . . . . . 3rd December 1987

Coming into operation . . . . . 3rd December 1987

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment in compliance with Article 107(2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) has considered both the interests of traffic and those of the owners and occupiers of adjoining property;

AND WHEREAS notice has been published in compliance with Article 108(1) of that Order;

AND WHEREAS the Department in compliance with Article 108(2) of that Order has taken such other steps as appear to it reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of persons likely to be specially affected, as the owners of land adjacent to the parking places to be designated, information as to the matters specified in Article 108(1)(a) to (c) of that Order;

AND WHEREAS the Department in compliance with Article 109(2) of that Order has considered all information furnished to it;

AND WHEREAS all objections received have been duly considered and notice of the Department's decision given to the persons by whom the objections were made;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 107(1), 109(2), 110, 111(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following bye-laws:—

*Citation and commencement*

1.—(1) These bye-laws may be cited as the On-Street Parking (Amendment) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 3rd December 1987.

*Bye-Laws Amended*

2. The On-Street Parking Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1987(b) shall be amended by the:—

(a) S.I. 1981/154 (N.I. 1)  
(b) S.R. 1987 No. 410

- (a) substitution of "15" for "16" where it appears in the heading to the second column of Part I of the Schedule;
- (b) substitution for items 8 and 15 in Part I of the Schedule of the items in the Schedule to these bye-laws;
- (c) deletion of item 16 from Part I of the Schedule.
