**ELECTRICITY SUPPLY****Electricity (Permitted Supply) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987**

*Made* . . . . . 21st December 1987

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 15th January 1988

Whereas the Department of Economic Development (hereinafter called "the Department") is satisfied that the persons referred to in the Schedule desire to obtain a supply of electricity from the Electricity Supply Board of the Republic of Ireland and whereas Northern Ireland Electricity(a) has given its consent to that supply:

Now, therefore, the Department in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 31 of the Electricity Supply (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and now vested in it(c), hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Electricity (Permitted Supply) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 15th January 1988.

*Permission of Department*

2. The Department hereby grants permission to the persons referred to in the Schedule to obtain from the Electricity Supply Board of the Republic of Ireland a supply of electricity for their premises at their respective addresses.
