The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 3(1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(**a**) and now vested in it(**b**) and of every power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1987.
