Gassing of Vermin (Revocation) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1987

Made 4th March 1987

Coming into operation 1st April 1987

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 6 of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland) 1949(a) and of every power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel(b), hereby makes the following scheme:

Citation and commencement

1. This scheme may be cited as the Gassing of Vermin (Revocation) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1987 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1987.

Revocation

2. The Gassing of Vermin Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1967(c) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the scheme.)

This scheme revokes the Gassing of Vermin Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1967 which enabled a retail seller of gassing powder to make a reduction in the price of gassing powder equal to one half of the normal retail price on production of an official certificate by the purchaser and which allowed that retail seller to apply to the Department for reimbursement.
