Local Government (General Grant) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1988

Made . . . . . 12th April 1988

Coming into operation . . . . . 1st June 1988

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of  
Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 3(1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1988.

*General grant*

2. For the purposes of paragraph 3(1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 the districts specified for the year ending 31st March 1989 shall be the districts listed below:—
