**Farm Diversification Grant (Amendment) Scheme
(Northern Ireland) 1988***Made* 27th May 1988*Coming into operation* 4th July 1988

The Department of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 16(1) of the Agriculture and Fisheries (Financial Assistance) (Northern Ireland) Order 1987(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department of Finance and Personnel, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Citation and commencement

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Farm Diversification Grant (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 4th July 1988.

Amendment to the Farm Diversification Grant Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1987

2. In Article 3(1)(a)(ii) of the Farm Diversification Grant Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1987(b), for "1000 hours" there shall be substituted "1100 hours".

This Scheme amends the Farm Diversification Grant Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1987, to increase the number of hours a person must spend in agricultural activities in relation to his agricultural business in order to be eligible for grant-aid, from 1,000 hours to 1,100 hours.
