ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**Control of Traffic (Newcastle) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made 10th June 1988

Coming into operation 31st July 1988

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Traffic (Newcastle) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 31st July 1988.

Prohibition of right-hand turn

2. A person shall not cause or permit a vehicle proceeding in a south-easterly direction along Harbour Road to make a right-hand turn while entering into South Promenade, Newcastle, at its southern junction with Harbour Road.

Prohibition of left-hand turn

3. A person shall not cause or permit a vehicle proceeding in a north-westerly direction along Harbour Road to make a left-hand turn while entering into South Promenade, Newcastle, at its northern junction with Harbour Road.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prohibits vehicles:—

1. from making a right-hand turn into South Promenade, Newcastle at its southern junction with Harbour Road; and
2. from making a left-hand turn into South Promenade, Newcastle at its northern junction with Harbour Road.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will be erected on the road.
