**Industrial and Provident Societies (Fees)
(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made 17th June 1988

Coming into operation 25th July 1988

The Department of Economic Development, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 29(2) and (4) and 97(1) of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1969(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Industrial and Provident Societies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 25th July 1988.

Amendment of fees

2. For Schedule 2(c) to the Industrial and Provident Societies Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969(d) there shall be substituted the following Schedule—

Regulation 20

Scale of fees payable for the inspection, or the furnishing of copies, of documents in the custody of the registrar or in connection with the exercise by the registrar of any of his functions under the Act.

3. The Industrial and Provident Societies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986(a) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations supersede the Industrial and Provident Societies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1986.

The Regulations generally increase by between 5% and 16% the fees to be paid in connection with the exercise by the registrar of friendly societies of functions under the Industrial and Provident Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1969 or for the inspection, or furnishing of copies, of documents in the custody of the registrar. However the fees have also been aligned, where appropriate, with the fees applicable to friendly societies and this has resulted in higher percentage increases in the fees for the acknowledgement of registration of a change in the situation of the registered office, for the reference of a dispute to the registrar, for the award of the registrar for the appropriation or division of the assets of a society on dissolution where the value of the assets is in excess of £600 and for the signature of the registrar on any document required to be signed by the registrar and not chargeable with any other fee.
