REGISTRATION OF CLUBS

**The Registration of Clubs (Certificate of Registration)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made 28th January 1988

Coming into operation 7th March 1988

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 7(1) of the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1987(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Registration of Clubs (Certificate of Registration) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 7th March 1988.

Form of certificate of registration

2.—(1) A certificate of registration shall be in the form set out in the Schedule.

(2) There shall be entered on each certificate such of the entries as are therein set out as relate to the order made by a county court upon the grant of the certificate or by a court of summary jurisdiction on renewal of that certificate.

(3) Every entry on the certificate shall be verified in the case of—

- (a) the grant of the certificate, by the signature of the chief clerk of the court which made the order and shall state the county court division for which the court acted when making the order; and
- (b) the renewal of the certificate, by the signature of the clerk of petty sessions for the court of summary jurisdiction which made the order and shall state the petty sessions district for which the court acted when making the order.

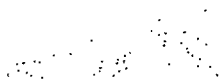

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations set out the form of a certificate of registration to be issued and renewed by the courts in respect of clubs registered under the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1987 for the supply and keeping for supply of intoxicating liquor on club premises.

Article 7(1) of the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1987 is the enabling provision under which these regulations are made. It is brought into operation on 1st February 1988 by the Registration of Clubs (1987 Order) (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988. (S.R. 1988 No. 1 (C. 1)).
