ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**Prohibition of Traffic (Moira Road/Hillsborough
By-Pass) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988**

Made 9th August 1988

Coming into operation 7th September 1988

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS one objection has been received and has been duly considered;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 22(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and being satisfied that the portion of the road specified in Article 2 cannot be used by vehicles without endangering the safety of the vehicles or persons using the road makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibition of Traffic (Moira Road/Hillsborough By-Pass) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 7th September 1988.

Prohibition

2. The use by vehicles of the portion of the Moira Road, Hillsborough, from its junction with the south bound carriageway of the Hillsborough By-Pass, Route A1, for a distance of 10 metres south-east of that junction is prohibited.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prohibits vehicles from using a portion of the Moira Road, Hillsborough, from its junction with the south bound carriageway of the Hillsborough By-Pass.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the Standard Scale (£400).
