Motor Vehicles (Authorisation of Special Types) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988

Made 11th August 1988 Coming into operation . . . 26th September 1988

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 29(3) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Authorisation of Special Types) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 26th September 1988.

Amendment

- 2. For Article 19(b)(ii) of the Motor Vehicles (Authorisation of Special Types) General Order (Northern Ireland) 1968(b) (interpretation) substitute the following-
 - "(ii) owing to its weight, cannot be carried by a heavy motor car or trailer or a combination of a heavy motor car and trailer which comply in all respects with the requirements of the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976(c) and have a total laden weight of not more than-
 - (A) prior to 1st October 1989, 32,520 kilograms, and
 - (B) on or after 1st October 1989, 38,000 kilograms.".

This Order amends the Motor Vehicles (Authorisation of Special Types) General Order (Northern Ireland) 1968 by amending the definition of abnormal indivisible load to provide phased higher thresholds for the total laden weight of a heavy motor car and trailer of 32,520 kilograms prior to 1st October 1989 and 38,000 kilograms on or after 1st October 1989.
