ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Road Traffic (Fixed Penalty) (Extension) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 198(2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) ("the Order") and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Fixed Penalty) (Extension) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 17th October 1988.

Specified offences

- 2.—(1) The offences under the Articles of the Order listed in column 2 of the Schedule are, subject to the exceptions and limitations, if any, set out in that column, specified for the purposes of Article 198(2) of the Order.
- (2) In relation to any Article in column 2 of the Schedule the entry in column 3 broadly describes offences under that Article.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

Article 198 of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 (the 1981 Order) specifies offences to which Articles 199 to 204 apply. This Order specifies additional offences to which these Articles apply (Article 2).

Any liability to conviction for those offences may be discharged by payment of a fixed penalty. The offences relate to contravention of:—

- (a) provisions controlling movement of and waiting by traffic, e.g. contravention of a mandatory direction arrow, a no entry sign, any direction of a police constable or traffic warden or indication given by a traffic sign (see items 3, 4 and 28 of the Schedule);
- (b) parking and obstruction provisions, e.g. contravention of a prohibition of parking a vehicle on a footway or verge (see items 5 and 31 of the Schedule);
- (c) lighting regulations, e.g. contravention of restrictions on movement of lamps, allowing vehicle to stand in such a position that a white light shown to the front of the vehicle is likely to be a source of danger or failing to extinguish front lamps on a stationary vehicle (see items 7 to 9 of the Schedule);
- (d) motor cycle driving provisions, e.g. rider or passenger not wearing a crash helmet or passenger not sitting on proper seat affixed to the motor cycle (see items 22 and 29 of the Schedule);
- (e) excessive noise provisions, e.g. sounding a horn at night in certain areas (see item 33 of the Schedule);
- (f) general motoring provisions, e.g. driving without a licence (item 1 of the Schedule), using a goods vehicle without a goods vehicle certificate (item 10), carrying a greater number of persons in a public service vehicle than that prescribed for the vehicle (item 14), failure to wear a seat belt (item 23), permitting a child under 14 years to travel in the front of a vehicle without wearing a seat belt (item 24), stopping on a zebra crossing (item 37), or 'Pelican' crossing (item 42).

The amount of the fixed penalty is provided by Article 203 of the 1981 Order as increased by the Fixed Penalty (Increase) Order (Northern Ireland) 1986 (S.R. 1986 No. 3). It amounts at the date of coming into operation of this Order to £12 but is subject to review.
