**One-Way Traffic (Portrush) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1988***Made* 22nd August 1988*Coming into operation* 2nd October 1988

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Portrush) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 2nd October 1988.

Amendment

2. The One-Way Traffic (Portrush) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979(b) shall be amended by the addition to Schedule 2 of the following item:—

Column 1	Column 2
Main Street from its junction with Kerr Street to its junction with Ramore Street.	Westerly from Kerr Street.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the One-Way Traffic (Portrush) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979.

The amendment provides for the introduction of a one-way traffic system in part of Main Street, Portrush.

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£400).

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will be erected on the road.
